Yesterday, I shared that we are taking several important steps to protect the health, safety, and well-being of our community while continuing our operations as best as we can. Thank you for depending on us to help you navigate through this challenging time, and we are committed to help as best as we can.

We will continue to monitor communications from the [CDC](#) and [MN Department of Health](#), and will remain in direct communication with the Office of Governor Tim Walz and Lieutenant Governor Peggy Flanagan to help elevate your concerns and questions.

**Effective March 19, 2020**, we are taking the additional following measures to create the safest possible environment for everyone:

- **Office Closures:** We have now decided to close all our direct service offices, except for our 394 University Avenue W. located in Frogtown which will be open for administrative work only and will not be open to the public. This closure is in addition to the office closures at Hmong Village and the Community School of Excellence that started today, March 18, 2020. **Office closures will continue through March 27<sup>th</sup>. However, it is likely that this timeline will be extended.**

We know this is a very difficult time. Please know that HAP’s leaders and our 100+ employees are doing everything we can to help make sure that you and your family have stability.
