



Smoking Statistics for the Hmong Community

In the survey of community members, **one** out of every **20** (5 percent) Hmong adults in Minnesota reported currently smoking

Among the Hmong, younger adults (37 percent) were more likely than older adults (17 percent) to report experimenting with smoking

- Hmong current smokers reported smoking their first cigarette at an average adult age of 20
- Hmong women smokers reported trying their first cigarette at the average age of 14, several years earlier than Hmong men smokers, who reported trying their first cigarette at the average age of 21.



46.2% of non-smokers had been exposed to secondhand smoke in the past 7 days.
